Business Analyst, Systems Analyst, Associate Consultant

### What Would you be Doing?

Your job would involve observing an outside company's procedures, morale, finances, manufacturing, or whatever issue or area is of concern, needs improvement or isn't performing properly. The consultant will perform a variety of tasks, as well as conduct surveys and studies to learn the organization and determine the source of the problem. Based upon those findings, the consultant will prepare a report or analysis of the situation and give recommendations for a solution.

### Graduate School and Special Programs

Entry level positions do not typically require a masters degree in business. Recruiters look for people who have demonstrated leadership, drive, commitment, maturity, and the ability to work well with others. Your campus and extracurricular activities are looked at very heavily. Recruiters also look for technical ability, communications skills, and previous work experiences.
