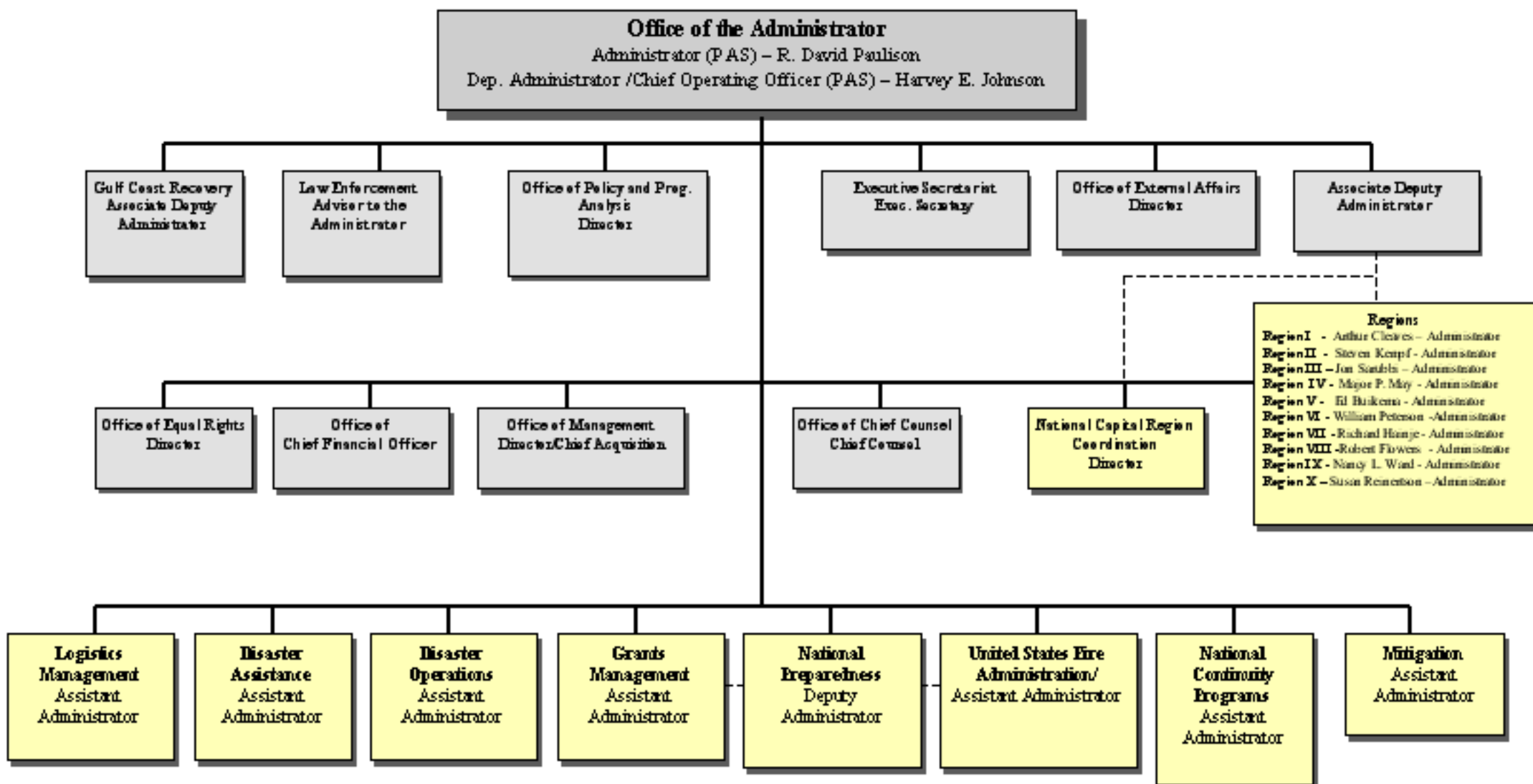

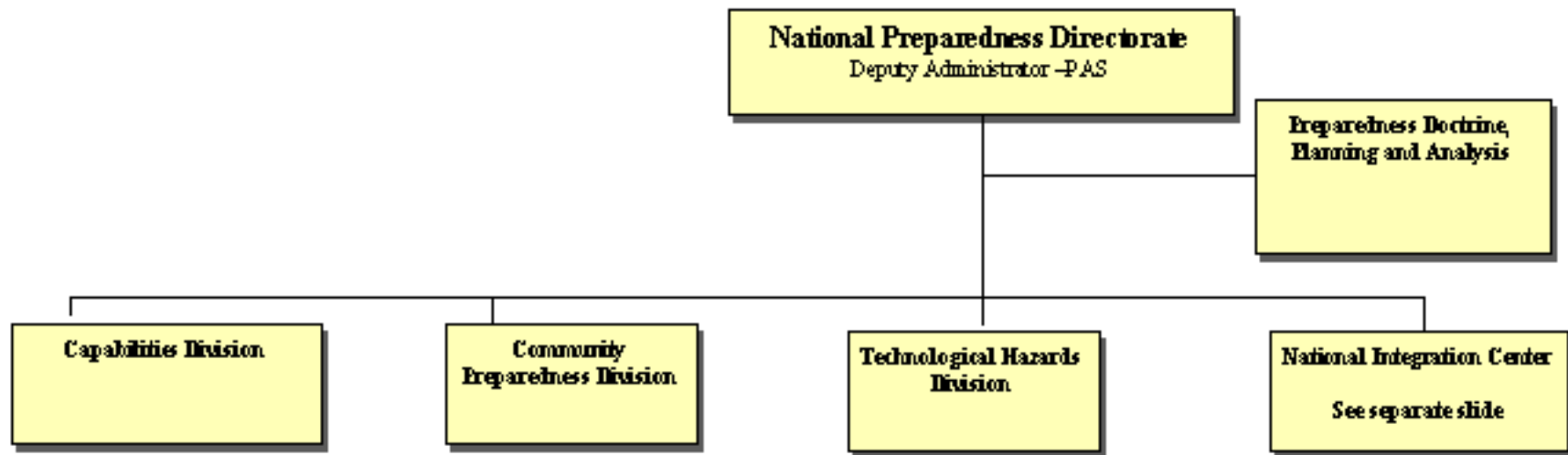

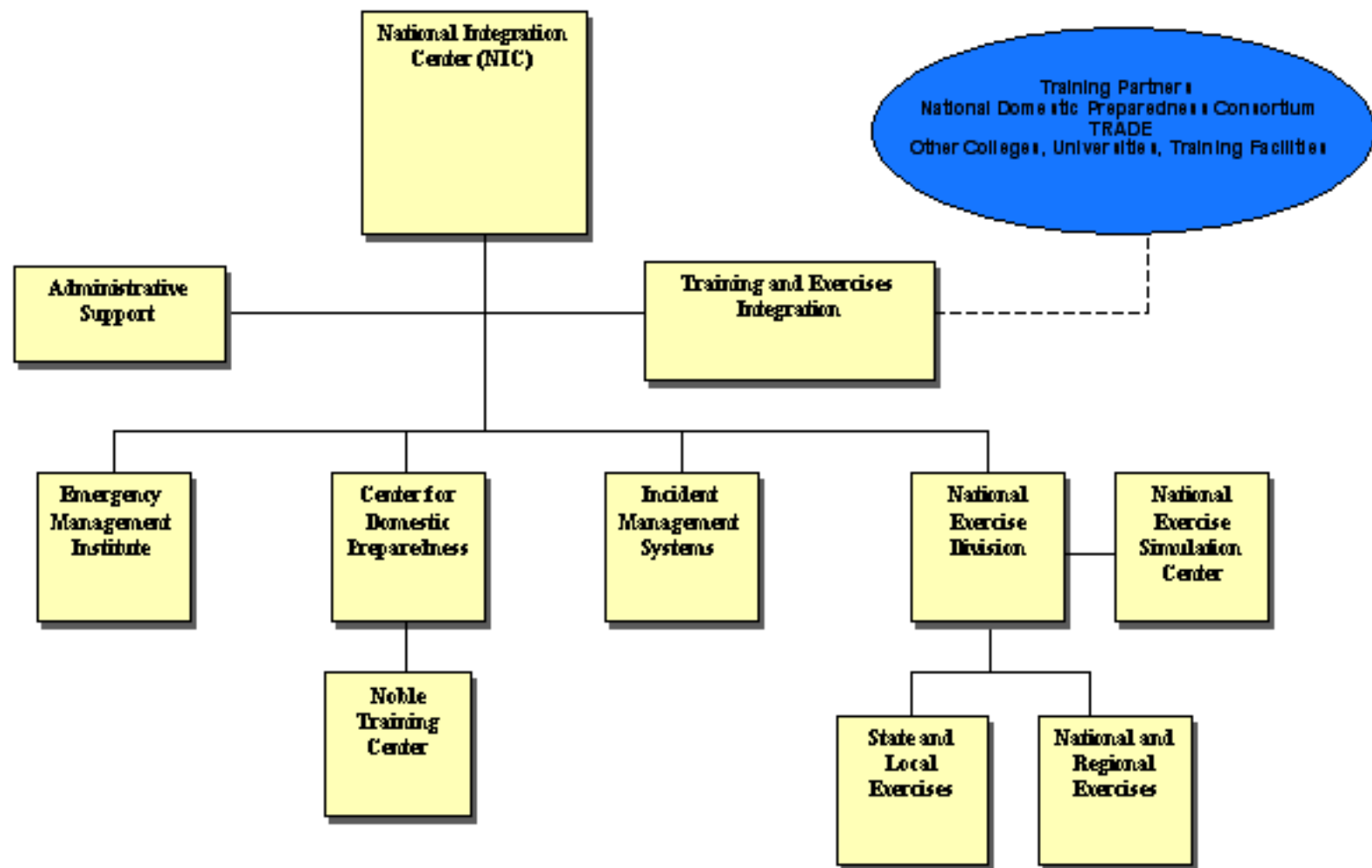
(A) Acting. Dotted Lines are Coordination. Solid Lines Are Command and Control
