

The National Climatic Data Center of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration officially recognizes the *Delaware State Climate Office* as the State Climate Office for the State of *Delaware*, with *Dr. David Legates* as State Climatologist. The Office shall have all the rights, privileges, and responsibilities of an ARSCO. The *Delaware State Climate Office* has demonstrated adequate support from the Northeast Regional Climate Center, the National Weather Service, the State of Delaware and the University of Delaware. Furthermore, having been certified by the American Association of State Climatologists as an ARSCO, official status as an AASC Recognized State Climate Office is thereby granted.

This memorandum of agreement supercedes all previous agreements between NCDC and State Climate Offices for the State of Delaware. Either party may, in writing, request a formal review of or prepare amendments to this agreement at any time. Changes will become effective upon written consent of all parties. This agreement may be terminated by either party with 90 days written notification or sooner by mutual consent.
