This internship program offers college-level undergraduate and graduate students an opportunity to join us in short projects or short-term contributions to larger efforts crossing a wide variety of professional settings throughout our NMNH community. The goal is to place interested and motivated undergraduate and graduate students, during their winter break, in a professional work environment at the National Museum of Natural History where they can...

- gain practical experience by working in a professional setting
- develop new skills by learning from NMNH professionals
- provide a service to the organization by contributing their time and talents
- create professional partnerships
- pursue their fields of interest related, or not, to their current profession
