CONSTITUTION

Article I -- Name

The Southern Baptist student organization of the University of Delaware, hereafter referred to as BCM, shall be called the Baptist Campus Ministries.

Article II -- Membership

Membership in BCM may be extended to any student expressing a desire to become a member of the organization.

Article III -- Objective

To provide a ministry to the campus community and to individuals in the campus community who have need for redemption and Christian growth.

Article IV -- BCM Council

There shall be a council of the BCM, consisting of the director, the faculty advisor, and student leaders.

Article V -- Meetings

The BCM Council shall meet at a time most convenient to the majority of the members. The BCM shall meet as often as is necessary to fulfill its objectives.

Article VI -- Budget

The necessary funds for BCM may be allocated by the Baptist Convention of Maryland/Delaware, by the Delaware Baptist Association, by Baptist churches, or by contributions from students in the organization. No dues are required for membership.

BYLAWS

Article I -- Officers

The officers of BCM shall be appointed by the Council annually. Vacancies shall be filled by the Council also. The duties of the officers shall be assigned through job descriptions which are approved by the Council.

Article II -- Amendments

The constitution and bylaws may be changed at any meeting of BCM, provided that the Council approves the changes, that prior notice of at least one week is given in each meeting of the BCM, and that threefourths of the quorum vote for such changes.

The quorum shall be the average number of members actively participating in BCM during the current semester, as determined by the director. For the purpose of determining a quorum, Winter term shall be considered part of Fall Semester; Summer terms shall be considered part of Spring semester.
