BY-LAWS OF
THE UNIVERSITY OF DELAWARE GOSPEL CHOIR

PURPOSE: To provide an avenue for students who desire to sing gospel music, and to share gospel songs with the community and other institutions.

OBJECTIVE: To present the choir to the University community and the community at large.

CRITERIA FOR
MEMBERSHIP : Full-time undergraduate matriculating^{ed} students.

OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES

PRESIDENT: To oversee the overall functioning of the choir to include rehearsals, engagements, administration duties, the organization of meetings, the proficiency of the other officers, etc.

FIRST VICE

PRESIDENT: To assist the President with duties as delegated by the President. Will assume presidency when the President's term is completed. Is in charge of the calendar, which includes the scheduling and confirming of engagements. Relays information to the secretary.

SECOND VICE

PRESIDENT: Assumes duties as delegated by the President. Arranges for transportation for choir to and from engagements. Assists secretary whenever necessary.

SECRETARY: Handles all correspondence. Keeps attendance for rehearsals and engagements. Picks up the mail for the choir from the mailbox, which is to be reviewed by the President. Can request assistance from any officer.

TREASURER: Responsible for all financial transactions which include preparing of choir budget, signing and cashing of checks, maintaining books and records.

CHAPLAIN: Opens and closes rehearsal.

Note: It is every officer's job to relay all necessary information to the other officers and to the President so that all officers are informed regarding the choir.

The officers will appoint no more than two directors.

The Music Committee is comprised of all officers, musicians, directors, and one representative from each section to be appointed by the officers. The Music Committee shall meet a minimum of twice a month.

Elections will be held once every academic year. The President will assume term until s/he steps down, graduates, or is removed by a two-thirds vote of the officers.

ELIGIBILITY FOR HOLDING A POSITION

President: Must be a junior or senior

Any other

office: Must be a member of the choir for one year with good to excellent attendance.

VOTING

Nominees will present a speech on:

- what qualities and/or skills they ^{feel they can contribute} possess to bring to the position
- why they have chosen to run for this office
