1. **Name Of Organization:** Physical Education Major's Club

2. **The purpose of the organization:**

The Physical Education Major's Club will serve as an umbrella organization for the College of Physical Education and Recreation. It is the goal of this club to increase interaction between the students and faculty representing all the departments within the College by sponsoring various social and professional events throughout the year.

 4. To increase involvement in professional organizations.
- b. Describe ways in which the University community benefit from this club:

The club provides activities that promote education, personal development, fitness, and safety in the University community.

3. **Qualifications for membership (a) and for holding office (b):**

- a. Any undergraduate or graduate student in the College of Physical Education and Recreation:
Current Dues: \$10
- b. Must be an active member for at least on semester to hold an office. Elections will be held at the end of each spring semester. Office of president must be held by a student of junior or senior status.

4. **Officers**

- a. **President:** Act as a liaison to the University of Delaware Student Organization Center. Presides over all club meetings, presents the agenda of each meeting and oversees other officers.
- b. **Vice-President:** Acts in place of the president in his/her absence and oversees the duties of the committee chairpersons.
- c. **Treasurer:** To keep an accurate account of all receipts and expenditures of the club and pay all bills incurred by the club as approved by that body.
- d. **Secretary:** To record the minutes of all executive and group meetings; to present records of previous meetings to the group; handles all general club correspondence.

5. Meetings

- a. The club shall meet at least once a month, during the months of the academic year.
- b. All meetings are open to faculty and students of the College of PEAR.

6. Ratification

This constitution shall be ratified by a two-thirds affirmative vote of the membership of this club and approval of the club's registration by the Student Activities Office.

7. Amendments

Amendments to this constitution shall require a two-thirds approval of the entire membership of this club. Advance notice must be made to all members of the proposed changes to the constitution.
