

We, the students at the University of Delaware, do hereby form the organization known as the Magic: The Gathering Club for the purpose of hosting free and entry based tournaments and providing an opportunity for students to network with other students with similar interests.


- I. **Name of the group** - The organization shall be known as the Magic: The Gathering Club.
- II. **Object of the organization** - The club will host tournaments for members to play in every week. There will be free play sessions, trade sessions and ladder matches as well. Members will have many outlets to compete against one another for little to no cost.
- III. **Qualification/Criteria for selecting membership** - Full time, matriculated undergraduate students at the University of Delaware who agree with the purpose and object of this group. A member will be defined as any student who has paid dues to Magic: The Gathering Club. There is no size limit on the number of members.
- IV. **Non-Discrimination Clause** - Magic: The Gathering Club agrees to adhere to all policies and procedures of the University and all local, state, and federal laws. Members will become acquainted with policies and procedures in the Official student handbook and other policies and procedures provided by the University. This organization is a viable, functioning organization, composed of at least six full time undergraduate students and we do not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, gender, age, religion, national origin, veteran, handicap status, or sexual orientation.
- V. **Duties and privileges of membership** - Members of Magic: The Gathering Club will be allowed to attend all meetings of said group. They will be allowed to compete in all events hosted by the club including: free tournaments, entry based tournaments, ladder matches and tournaments, and trading sessions. Each member will have the right to vote for the executive board during election time. Non-members will not be allowed to participate in club competitions, but will be allow to attend general club meetings.
- VI. **Absence Policies** -There are no penalties for not attending general club meetings. If a member signs up to attend an entry based tournament and does not attend, they forfeit any upfront costs incurred and will require presidential approval in order to attend future entry based tournaments.
- VII. **Policies and Procedures for Disciplining/Removing members-** A member may be removed from the club if he/she is disruptive during club meetings, functions and/or competitions. The following are grounds for dismissal: cheating in a tournament, assisting other players while not in a match, disrupting any players competing against each other and reporting false ladder results, and stealing any possession of another member at any time. Membership removal requires a simple majority vote of the executive board.
- VIII. **Qualifications for Officers** - All Officers (or Executive Board Members) **MUST** be full time matriculated undergraduate students at the University of Delaware with a **minimum** GPA of 2.25.
- IX. **Officers** - Magic the Gathering Club will have the following executive board members: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Public Relations Chair and Sergeant at Arms. The duties of each executive board member are defined as follows:
 - a. **Section 1: President** - This organization shall have a President with the duties of calling and running meetings and handling day-to-day

XIX. Rules for amending the Constitution – Adding articles/sections to the constitution requires a 2/3 vote of the executive board and advance notice to all members of the proposed change.
