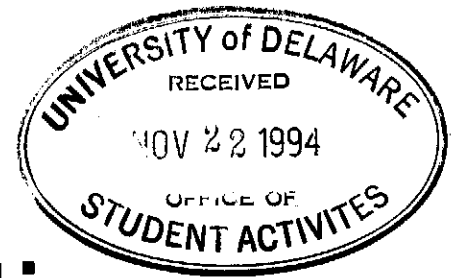


CONSTITUTION OF THE STUDENT BRANCH OF THE SOCIETY OF AUTOMOTIVE ENGINEERS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF DELAWARE.

This Student Branch has been chartered by the Society of Automotive Engineers and is subject to the Constitution, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the present Society.

The purpose of this organization is to provide opportunities for members to gain broader insight into the engineering profession by sponsoring meetings that will bring practicing engineers to the campus, arranging field trips to research and engineering establishments, and participating in local SAE Section activities. We hope to allow students to demonstrate their knowledge as well as gain engineering experience through sponsored projects. It shall also be the purpose of this organization to encourage good fellowship among engineering students and their professors.

The name of this organization shall be "The Student Branch of the Society of Automotive Engineers at the University of Delaware, Inc."

Students attending the University of Delaware who are SAE student members or SAE members are qualified to become members of this organization.

Officers of the organization shall be elected by a majority vote of the Student Branch once a year, at least one month before the end of the spring semester. Elected officers shall take office at the close of the Spring Semester and shall serve for one full year. The officers of this organization shall be:

President
Vice-President
Secretary
Treasurer

The responsibilities of these officers are as follows:

President - The President shall preside over Student Branch Business Meetings and meetings of its Executive Committee

Vice-President - The Vice-President shall assume the responsibilities of the President should the President be unable to perform his/her duties.

Secretary - The Secretary shall maintain the Student Branch membership records and prepare minutes of all business and executive committee meetings.

Treasurer - The Treasurer shall keep a record of the Student Branch's income and disbursements and advise the Executive Committee of the Branch's financial status.

The President, with the agreement of the other officers, shall appoint chairpersons of committees which are deemed necessary to carry on the activities of the Student Branch, including:

- Membership Committee
- Program Committee
- Trip Committee
- Reception Committee
- Publicity Committee

The chairpersons of these committees may appoint other Branch members to assist them. The Executive Committee shall consist of the elected officers, standing committee, and the Faculty Advisor.

The Student Branch will have a Faculty Adviser at all times. It is the Faculty Advisor's responsibility to consult with the Student Branch officers on matters pertaining to SAE and school policies, to serve as a liaison between the Student Branch, the society, and the local SAE section, and to advise the officers of the Student Branch.

The Student Branch shall hold a minimum of six technical meetings and two business meetings through the academic year. Business meetings may be held in conjunction with technical meetings. Each meeting will include a Secretary's report, Treasurer's report, pertinent committee reports, old business, and new business. A quorum shall consist of one-third of the members in good standing.

Student Branch dues shall consist of ten dollars per year, in addition to the fee established by the Society for SAE student membership. The Branch dues go to the Branch treasury, while the student membership fee will be promptly forwarded to the SAE headquarters.

This Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of members at any regularly scheduled meeting of the Branch, provided that the proposed amendment has been read and discussed at the previous scheduled meeting. An amendment may be proposed by the executive committee or by a signed petition of ten or more members.

Ratification of this Constitution will be ratified following a two-thirds affirmative vote by the members, and the approval of this organization's registration by the Student Activities Office.
