

CLOSET EXERCISE

Anthropology 101

Due: Tuesday, October 22, 2009

Purpose: To have students investigate the impact of globalization in their personal lives

What to Do: Go through the clothes in your closet (and/or in your drawers, on your floor, etc if you need a larger sample size!) and record the country of origin from the label of each item of clothing.

Report Outline: Make a 3 column table that summarizes your data. The first column should list your countries in order of frequency – the most frequently used should be listed first, the least frequently used should be listed last. The second column should show the frequency of each country. The third column should indicate the kinds of clothes identified for each country along with their frequency [e.g., jeans (4), T-shirts (12), etc].

Then, either below your table or on the other side of the page or on a second page, make a bullet-point list of at minimum of 5 and a maximum of 10 meaningful conclusions that can be drawn from the data in your table. 10 conclusions are better than 5!!!!!!!!!!

This assignment is worth 15 points. It should be **type**-written with regular sized margins and font size. Two page assignments should be **stapled**.
