

Required Fee Descriptions

New Student Orientation Fee-	This is a one-time fee charged to all new undergraduate students in order to support the orientation programs for new students. All new undergraduate students are required to pay this fee whether or not they were able to attend DelaWorld 101.
Student Health Service Fee -	This is a mandatory fee charged to all full-time students entitling the student to use the Student Health and Counseling Centers. Part-time, matriculated students are eligible to receive the Health Center services by contacting the Student Health Center or they may use the facilities on a fee-for-service basis. A booklet which further describes the services of the Student Health and Counseling Centers is mailed to you separately.
Student Center Fee -	This is a mandatory fee charged to all full-time students to cover amortization of bonds used in the construction of the Trabant University Center and renovations to the Perkins Student Center, as well as operating costs of these student centers.
Student Comprehensive Fee -	This is a mandatory fee charged to all undergraduate and CEND students during the regular semesters and during the Winter and Summer Sessions. This fee supports the student fitness center, recreational programs, student activities, concerts, performing arts and the activities of registered student organizations.
Registration Fee-	This is a mandatory fee charged to all part-time Undergraduate, Graduate and CEND students
