

## Is CLSC For Me?

Potential CLSC students should meet the following criteria:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Be at least 18 years old
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have or will have completed high school prior to enrollment (certificate of completion, GED, diploma)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have a documented intellectual disability
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have or had an IEP (Individualized Education Program)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Provide own transportation to and from the University of Delaware campus
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have the capacity to be independent and unsupervised while on campus (e.g. going to and from classes, participating in recreational activities) with or without accommodation
- \_\_\_\_\_ Demonstrate functional communication skills in academic, work, and social settings with or without accommodation

CLSC is ideally suited for students who are interested in pursuing a full-time postsecondary education with the ultimate goal of developing skills necessary for employment and independent living.

Qualified Delaware residents will be given priority.
