

Adi Patel Undergraduate Research Scholarship

Description:

- Established in memory of Adi Patel, who was supervisor of ITV Operations in Information Technologies/Media Services at the time of his death in 1997.
- This fund shall be used for a scholarship awarded to students who are conducting undergraduate research under the supervision of faculty in the department of Communication.
- Multiple scholarships may be awarded annually. The scholarship will be applied to cover tuition, as a way to offset the costs of conducting the research project. Award amounts will vary. The total amount available annually is \$1200.

Criteria:

- Applicants who are Communication majors will be given priority. Communication Interest students will have next priority. Students in other majors who are conducting research under the supervision of Communication faculty are also eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be a sophomore, junior or senior. They must have a specific research project in development, supervised by a member of the Communication faculty.
- Applicants will be evaluated according to the quality of their research proposal. This proposal should be a 1-2 page summary of the research, including the general topic, a statement of its significance, your research questions or hypotheses, and a description of your methodology.
- Applicants must also provide a budget for your project, estimating the costs you will incur.
- Applicants must also provide a letter of support from their Communication faculty supervisor.
- Applicants must present the results of their research at a department colloquium upon completion of the project.
