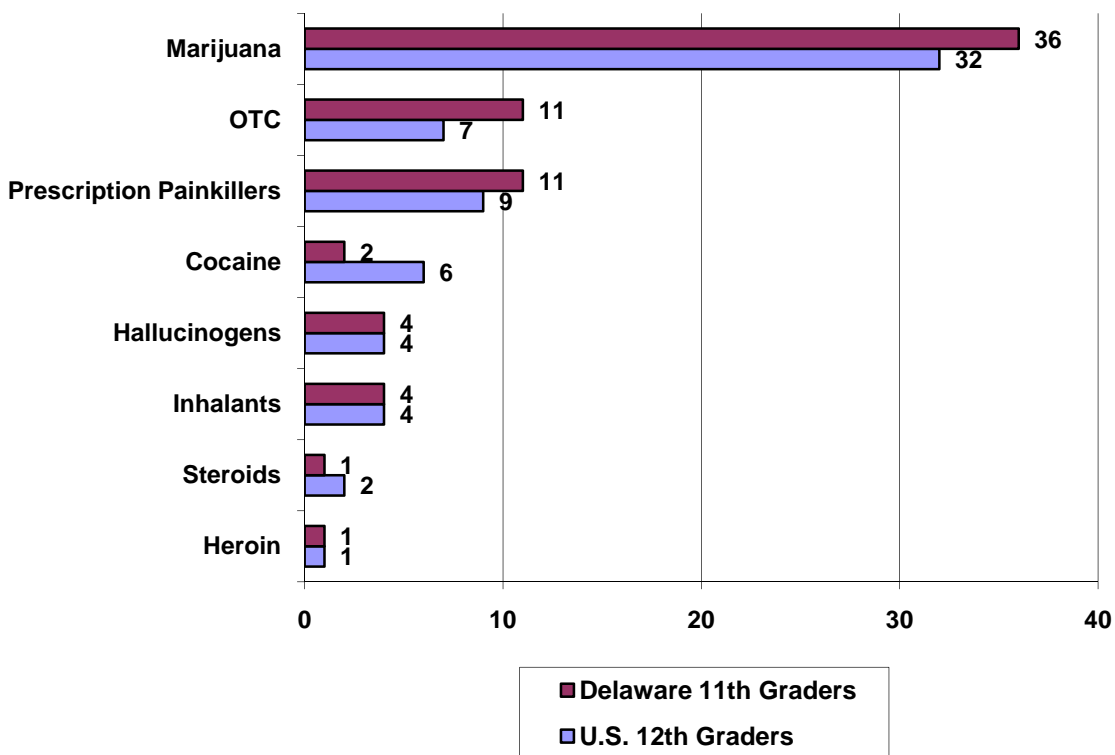

Delaware Teens More Likely to Abuse Marijuana, Prescription Painkillers and Over-the-Counter Drugs than National Norms

Delaware teens are more likely to report abuse of marijuana, Over-the-counter drugs, and prescription painkillers than is reported nationally, but are less likely to report use of cocaine.
