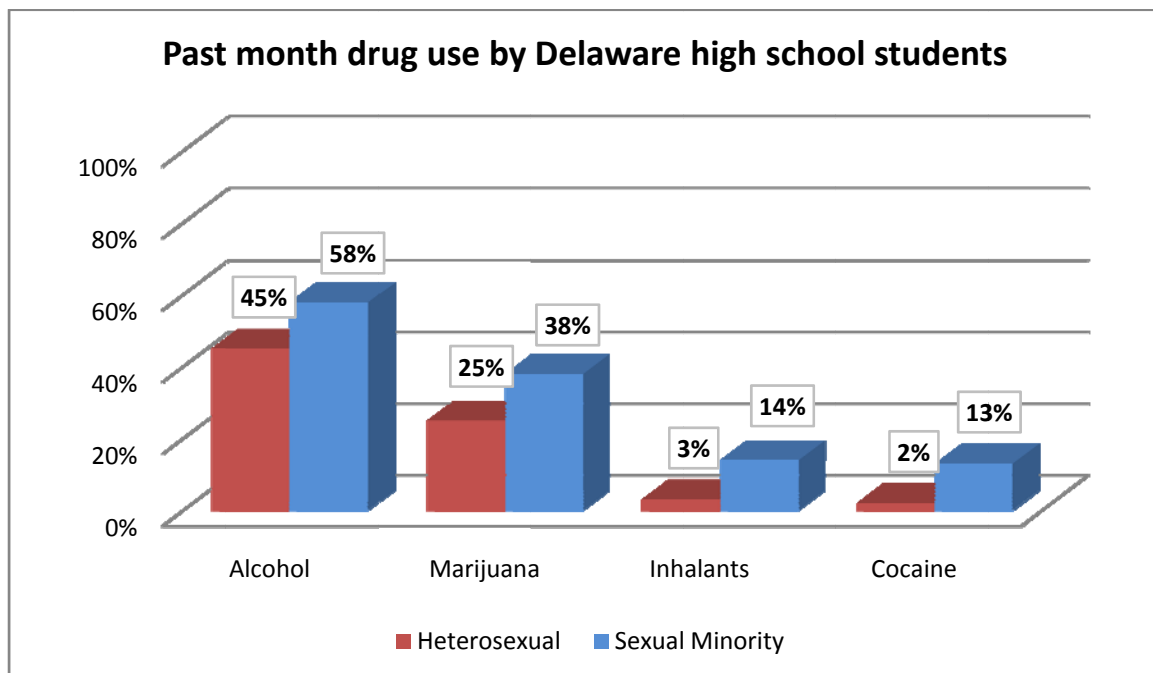

Sexual Minorities and Risk of Drug Use in Delaware Schools

High school student who identify themselves as bisexual or homosexual are more likely to report drug use than students who identify as heterosexual. More specifically, they are 29% more likely to have drunk alcohol in the past 30 days, 52% more likely to have smoked marijuana, 367% more likely to use inhalants to get high, and 550% more likely to use cocaine.
