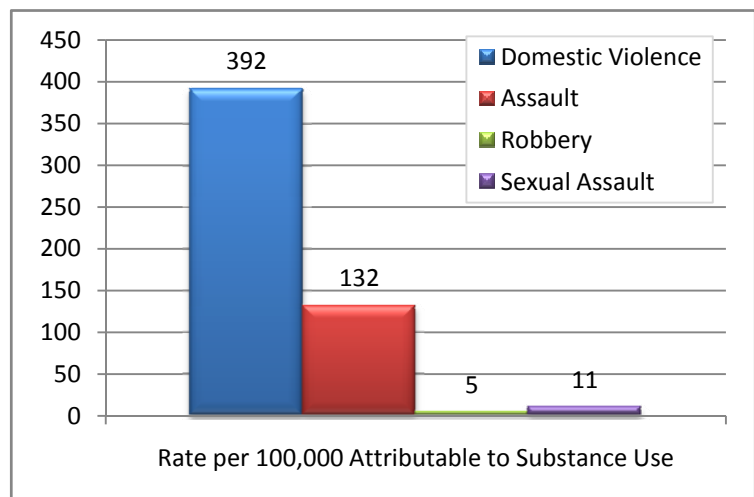

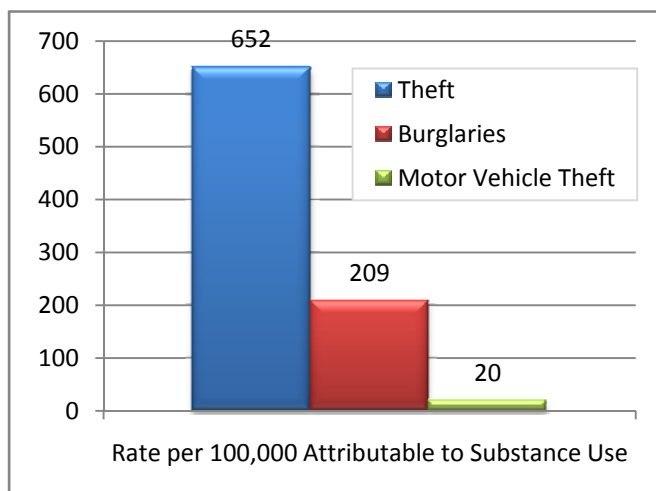
Crimes in Delaware and Substance Use

According to 2005 Delaware crime data, alcohol related domestic violence is one of the more common substance-related violent crimes, occurring more than twice as often as other major substance-related violent crimes. Assault was the next most common. The more serious crimes of robbery and sexual assault were less commonly associated with substance use.

Property Crime Related to Alcohol & Illegal Drugs



Data about property crimes indicates that thefts were the most common substance-related property crime, being more than three times as common as others. Burglaries were also relatively likely. Substance-related motor vehicle thefts were less common.
