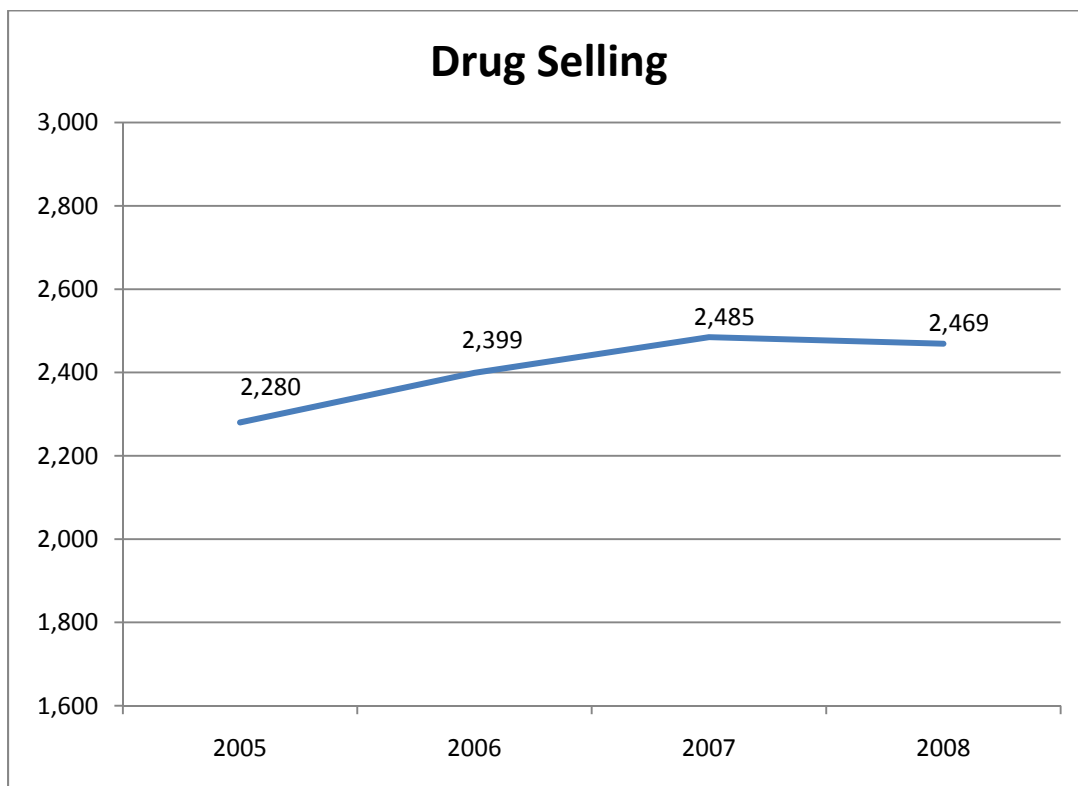

### *Reported Drug Dealing Trend in Delaware*

Despite slight inclines a few years ago, reported incidences of illegal drugs being sold remain steady according to a report by Delaware's Statistical Analysis Center. Drug dealing, which includes possession with intent to deliver and drug trafficking incidents reported to the police, increased by about 5% in 2006 and by about 4% in 2007. This was followed in 2008 by a 1% decline in reported drug selling. With data for only the first quarter of 2009 available currently, it is unclear as to whether rates will increase or decrease this year.
