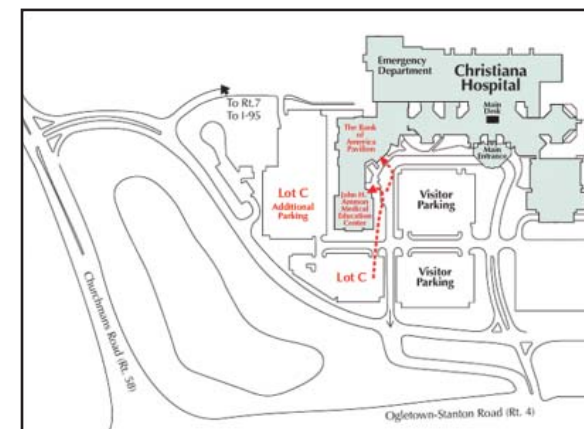
John H. Ammon Medical Education Center at Christiana Hospital
