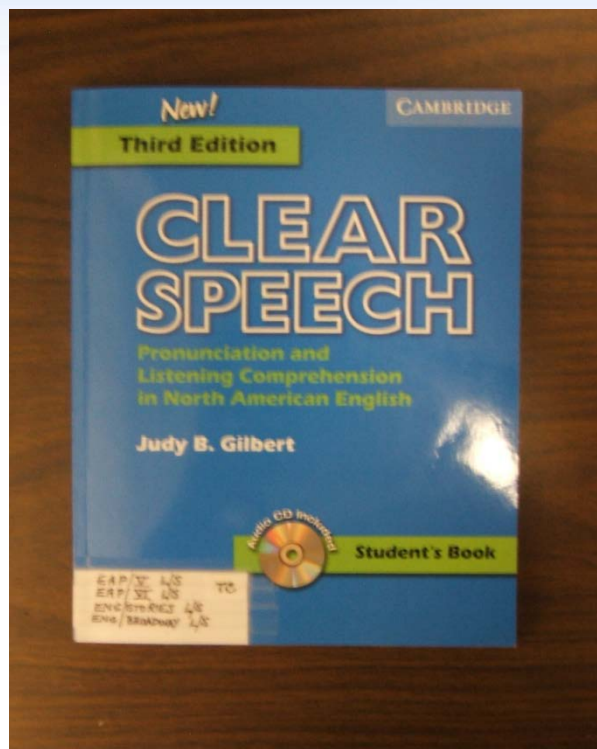

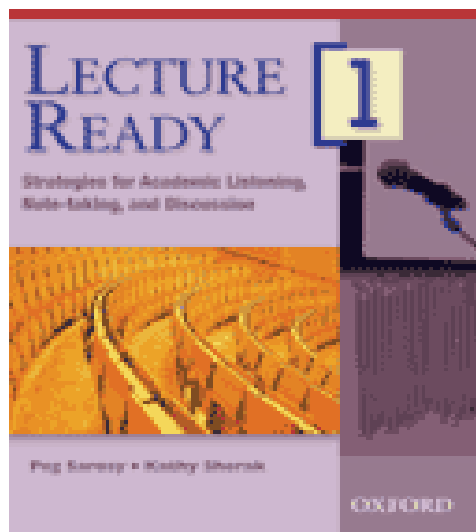

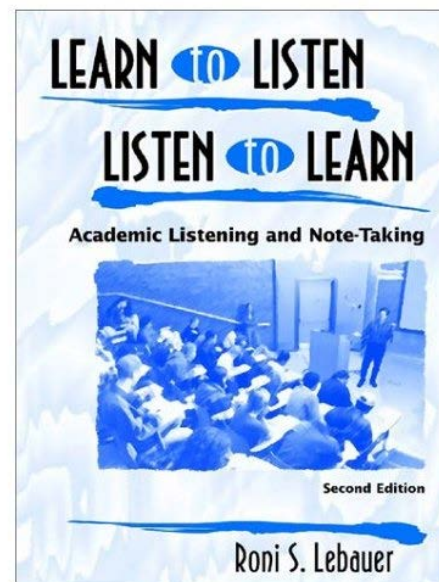

Outcomes – Listening: Students will:

- Understand the content (main ideas and some details) of an academic lecture
- Understand the organization and development of an academic lecture, including rhetorical signals
- Understand natural speech including reductions and contractions.
- take notes from academic lectures and readings

Outcomes – Speaking: Students will

- Summarize read and heard information
- express and support opinions and arguments
- Speak with correct and more complex spoken grammar
- Understand and use new vocabulary from a variety of academic subjects

Activities

- Academic lectures with note-taking
 - Listening strategies
 - Note-taking strategies
- Group discussion with reports
 - Discussion strategies
 - Oral grammar practice
 - Pronunciation practice – academic and everyday language
