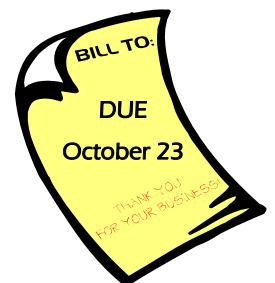

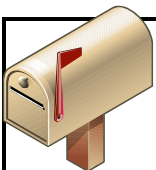
Christiana Towers Dorms
