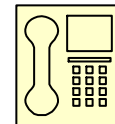

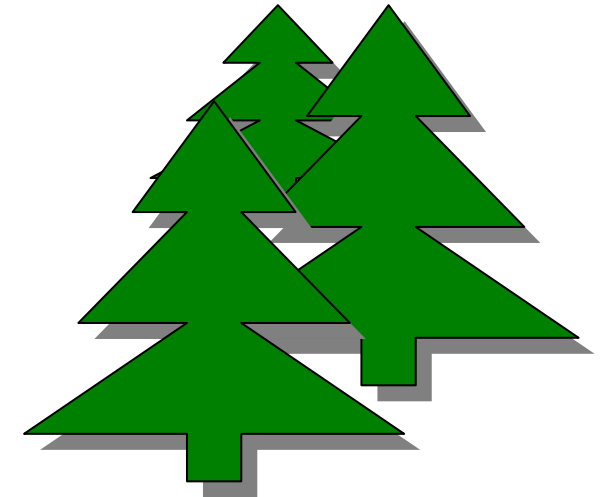

## Helpful information for

### ARRIVING IN PARK PLACE

When you arrive at Park Place, you will need to go to the office which is located in the Towne Court complex across the street from Park Place. The office has a blue awning over the door. At the office, please tell the office workers that you are a new ELI student. You will be asked to sign a contract for the session you will stay at Park Place. You must pay the session fee in full at this time. You can pay by credit card, traveler's checks or money order. You will also need to make a \$250.00 cleaning deposit which will be returned to you after you move out if you leave your apartment clean and in good condition.

After signing the contract, you will be given a key to your apartment and the security code for the outside door of the building. Each apartment also has one mailbox key which you may be given at this time.

If you want to buy the linen package for your bed you can buy it at the Towne Court office.

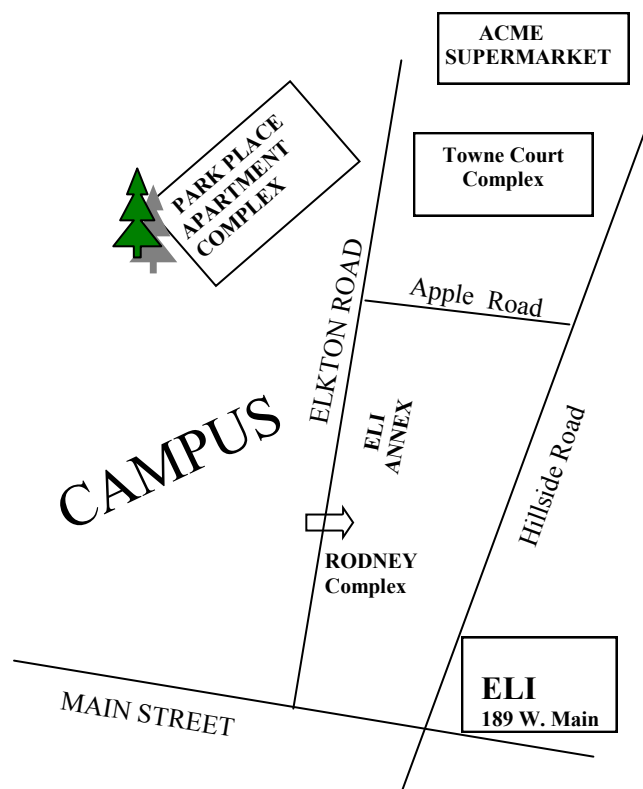
If you would like to borrow a vacuum cleaner to use to clean your Park Place apartment, please contact the ELI RA.

## Living in Park Place

Please come to the ELI main office building at 8:30 on the next business day after you arrive so we can check you into the university and give you all the information you will need to get ready to begin your program of study at the ELI.

### FAST FACTS for FIRST DAYS

- The ELI Office is open from 8:00 –5:00, Monday– Friday.
- Placement testing is held on the Thursday and Friday before the first day of the new session. Please bring your documents with you.
- ELI students can buy a meal plan for the university dining halls. Ask for information at the ELI business office window.
- The water in your apartment and in Newark is safe to drink.
