8 Week Teaching Plan for OB IV

Oral Business Level IV

The primary goal of OB IV is to develop the students' ability to communicate in an American business setting. Listening, intelligibility and fluency are practiced through Intensive pronunciation practice of business vocabulary and idioms, role playing, discussions, oral presentations, and mock interviews. Students are taken to a local company for a firsthand experience of American business and a chance to use their newfound knowledge of business English.
