MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

Thirteen courses (39 credits), as follows:

Ten courses in Italian (30 credits):

One ITAL 2xx	3
ITAL 211 or ITAL 212	3
ITAL 305 or ITAL 306	3
Two of ITAL 310, 311, 355	6
Two of ITAL 4xx (literature)	6
One ITAL 4xx	3
Two of ITAL 3xx, 4xx	6

A three-credit capstone experience (FLLT 490 or FLLT 495) 3
 (An ITAL 4xx capstone or a senior thesis also fulfills this requirement)

Two courses (6 credits) at the 200-level or above, chosen
 with the prior approval of the advisor, from the following areas: 6
 Italian, Art History, Comparative Literature, English,
 Foreign Languages and Literatures, History, Music,
 Philosophy, Political Science, or Theatre.

NOTE: Students wishing to pursue a **linguistics** option in Italian Studies should consult their advisor or the Associate Chair of the department.
