MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

13 courses (39 credits), as follows:

Four courses (12 credits) in RUSS Electives at the 200-level and above	12
Four courses (12 credits) in RUSS Literature at the 300 or 400 level (at least six credits must be at the 400-level)	12
FLLT 327 Topics: Russian Literature in Translation	3
FLLT 375 Topics: Russian and Soviet Culture in Translation	3
A three-credit capstone experience (FLLT 490 or FLLT 495)	3
(A RUSS 4xx capstone or a senior thesis also fulfills this requirement)	
Two courses (6 credits) at the 200-level or above, chosen with prior approval of the advisor and according to option requirements, from the following nine areas:	6
Russian, Art History, Comparative Literature, English, Foreign Languages and Literatures, History, Linguistics, Music, Political Science.
