### MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

#### *First Language*

Two first-language courses at the 200-level and above ..... 6

Three courses in literature at the 300 and 400-level ..... 9  
(at least one course at each level)

Three additional courses at the 300 and 400 level ..... 9

#### *Second Language*

Two courses at the 200-level and above ..... 6

Three courses in literature at the 300 and 400-level ..... 9  
(at least one course at each level)

One additional course at the 400 level ..... 3

#### *Third Language*

Four third-language courses ..... 12  
(at least two courses at or above the 200 level for Western language)

**A three-credit capstone experience** (FLLT 490 or FLLT 495) ..... 3  
(A Senior thesis or equivalent fulfills the capstone requirement)

#### **Notes:**

(1) Selection of First and Second Languages is limited to those languages in which the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures offers a major or a minor.

(2) Students enrolled in the Three Languages Major are strongly encouraged to participate in at least one of the study abroad programs sponsored by the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures.

### ELECTIVES

After required courses are completed, sufficient elective credits must be taken to meet the minimum credit requirement for the degree.
