- 4) Changes minimum required GPA from 3.25 to 3.0 to be consistent with University policy and the tracking performed by the office of the Assistant Provost for Graduate & Professional Education.
- 5) Establishes rules for evaluating graduate course credit earned at other institutions and waiving some credit requirements for UD MSEG program when appropriate.
- 6) Describes Master's Thesis requirements.
- 7) Eliminates internal inconsistencies in policy.
