- 4. When you come to your onboarding appointment, please bring the following:
  - The <u>Bayh-Dole Act Form</u> "Agreement to Assign"
  - Voided check from your U.S. bank account
- 5. Visit the <u>Office of Graduate and Professional Education</u> located at <u>234 Hullihen Hall</u> to submit final, official academic documents (transcripts, degree certificates, etc.)
