Thank you for making my first season an enjoyable experience, and I look forward to expanding and developing the program.

Once again this summer, we will be offering our in-house hockey league, as well as a power skating clinic. In addition, Mark Catron again will operate his Players Edge Hockey Camp the week of Aug. 16, 2004, at the University's Gold Ice Arena. While summer is a great time to get outside and enjoy the sun, it's also a good time to continue to develop your hockey skills in a fun, friendly, learning environment. We have designed the summer in-house league during the evening so you can take full advantage of your summer days. Each week, teams will have a practice and a game, and the team practice and games are on the same night each week to make scheduling your other summer activities easier.

ALL players ages 7 & under are required to play summer cross ice hockey. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS. Since the DVHL this upcoming season is requiring all mite teams to practice at least half the time with cross ice, all players ages 7 & under will be required to play summer cross ice hockey. Players will not be allowed to move up to the 8-10 in-house age level unless they turn 8 during June or July 2004.

This flyer provides more detailed information on the summer in-house league, with a schedule of practice and game times by age group. Also listed are the beginning and end dates of the summer season.

As a special thank you for your past participation, below are two free public session passes that you can use this summer. I hope you have a safe and enjoyable summer, and I look forward to seeing you on the ice at UD. Power Skating

Skating requires a lot of practice and is more important than all other hockey skills. It must be focused on individually to show significant improvement.

Power Skating is designed to improve the skating ability of hockey players of all ages. Each session uses a combination of drills and instruction to elevate the players' ability to new levels.

This course is an excellent opportunity to improve skating skills.

All students must have completed Hockey 2 in the Instructional Hockey Program or a comparable class to be eligible for Power Skating.
