QUALIFICATIONS: Earned doctorate (ABD considered) with expertise in adolescent/youth development. Candidates must be able to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in human development, family studies, and/or research methods. Individuals who have a desire to teach statistics at the graduate level are especially encouraged to apply. A record of published scholarship, university teaching, and the ability to work in an interdisciplinary environment focused on human development, families, and communities is preferred.

PROGRAM: The Department of Human Development and Family Studies offers B.S., M.A., M.S., and Ph.D. degrees. The Department has an NAEYC accredited Laboratory Preschool, an accredited Human Services program, administers an Early Head Start program, and is a partner in the development of an Early Learning Center. The Department also has strong collaborative relations with the Center for Disabilities Studies, and the Center for Community Research and Service.

COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY: The University of Delaware has an enrollment of approximately 17,000 undergraduates and 3,000 graduate students. The College of Human Services, Education, and Public Policy (CHEP) is the second largest college.
