1. A brief discussion of the meeting started with Silvana Bastin offering to setup a Sustainability presentation during Spring 2008. Previous scenarios acted out were blistering release, meth lab blast, dirty bomb scenario. A Dept. of Homeland Security committee has been newly formed within the ACHMM. Future National meetings will be San Diego in 2009 and BALTIMORE in 2010.

3. Carol briefly reviewed the Treasurer and bank statements from Dave L.
4. Carol presented a talk on HAZMAT and the concept of needing to educate the public on chemicals and the long term effects from exposure. The topic was entitled "Color of Hazmat-Can We Teach it To Our Youth?". She presented this at the National Conference in Arlington, Va in August, 2007.
5. Kevin passed around three flyers from Delaware Health and Social Services on household pest, furniture polish hazards, and various treated "in the home" items such as dry cleaned clothes, carpets, and particle board products that release organic toxic vapors.
6. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for December 6, at the Iron Hill Brewery/Restaurant in Newark, DE. At 5:00PM.
7. Shane mentioned the email undeliverables issue and went over the current CHMM email list with Carol. It was decided to delete those people who cannot be reached at the presently listed email addresses except for those that Carol flagged for followup.
