Entry Requirements

All submissions must include a conceptual statement that explains the merits of your poster related to the competition theme in 100 words or less. Quality of writing and relevance to theme will be considered in the judging.

There is no fee for entering this competition. There is a limit of 2 submissions per person. All poster submissions must be between 16 and 18 inches wide and between 20 and 24 inches high for vertical posters, or vice-versa for horizontal posters. Posters can be black and white, grayscale or full-color.

How to Submit Your Poster

Posters must be submitted digitally as a ".pdf" file with all fonts and images embedded, or as a ".jpeg" file. Submissions must be actual size (100% scale), no more than 300 d.p.i. (dots per inch). Drop off or mail your poster, conceptual statement, and completed entry form on a CD-Rom or DVD-Rom (Mac or PC compatible) by the submission deadline to the following address:
