Leadership Intern Program

I. Purpose

The Leadership Intern Program has been implemented to promote mentoring of new members, to develop future chapter leaders, and to promote innovative chapter practices.

II. Procedure

- A. Each summer, the Leadership Succession Committee will determine the area of focus as well as the compensation package for the following year's Leadership Intern Program. This will be confirmed by the board.
- B. The Leadership Succession Committee will develop the application.
- C. At the induction orientation, a member of the Leadership Succession Committee or designee will communicate information about the Leadership Intern Program to new members. He/she will also be responsible for alerting other inductees not in attendance.
- D. Applications will be due early December. The Leadership Succession Committee will review applicants and make recommendations to the board.
- E. The Leadership Intern will be selected by the board during the month of January.
- F. The Leadership Intern's tenure generally lasts from February through May.
