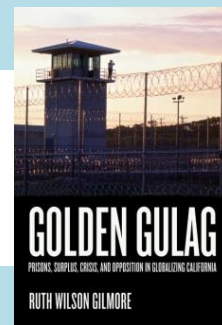
If all capitalism is racial capitalism,
