Mandatory Alcohol Education for All First Year Students:

PART 1 is due by February 27, 2012

All **Freshman & Transfer** Students are required to complete the course. **You will not be able to register for the next semester's classes until you complete the course!**

AlcoholEdu Directions for those entering UD Spring 2012:

- 1** You CANNOT begin the program until **January 27, 2012**.
- 2** Go to www.udel.edu/network and enter your **UDelNet ID** and **password**.
- 3** Click on "**Go to AlcoholEdu**" to begin the course.
- 4** Take **Part 1. Time: 2.5 hours**. Complete between **January 27 and February 27, 2012**. You don't have to do it all at once. **Pass the EXAM with an 80% OR HIGHER**.
- 5** **After 30 days**, you'll receive an e-mail to log back in and finish **Part 2** of the course, Go to: www.udel.edu/network and enter your **UDelNet ID** and **password**.
- 6** Take **Part 2. Time: 15–30 minutes**. Complete by **April 9, 2012**.
