4-H Event

- The Delaware 4-H staff established the following. This is to assure our clientele that all 4-H events advertised would adhere to standards set forth in policies adopted by the Delaware 4-H Youth Development Program.

What Can Be Called A 4-H Event/Program in Delaware?

Levels of Involvement

- <u>Club</u> Club events must be sponsored by a chartered or recognized 4-H club or group with events approved by the UDCES Organizational volunteer.
- <u>Club event where others are invited from outside the county</u> Events cannot be marketed across county lines without prior approval from the agent in county sponsoring the event to agents in other counties where invitation is being extended.
- <u>County Event</u> Must have approval of Extension staff member responsible for the 4-H program (4-H agent/educator) to be labeled XYZ event.
- <u>County event where other counties are invited</u> 4-H professional in host county must communicate the invitation.
- <u>Multi-County Events</u> A 4-H agent and/or professionals from all counties involved must be included in the planning and communication.
- <u>State</u> Any event listed and/or advertised as a state 4-H event or activity must have written approval of State 4-H Program Leader or designee.
- Across state lines Notification to other state by 4-H Program Leader.
