



NEED GARDEN ADVICE?

MASTER GARDENER RESIDENTIAL SITE VISITS

Do you need assistance identifying your property's existing trees, shrubs or flowers? Would you like maintenance recommendations or new ideas to reinvigorate your landscape? A visit from the University of Delaware Cooperative Extension New Castle County Master Gardeners (MGs) may be your answer.

A team of MGs will come to your home to offer suggestions on pruning, curb appeal, pest management, additions to your garden, and more. At least two MGs will spend up to two hours on-site discussing your landscape and addressing the priorities you have identified in your application.

In order to achieve the most satisfactory results from your visit we recommend taking notes, pictures, and/or sketching during the visit. At the conclusion of the visit, the team will provide you with a folder containing numerous resources to help you in your endeavor. Recommendations are made in accordance with the policies of Delaware Cooperative Extension. The \$100.00 registration fee helps to support MG educational initiatives and will be accepted when the site visit is completed. Please do not send payment in advance.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PROGRAM

Limitations

- Properties must be private residences in New Castle County, Delaware.
- No on-going commitment is implied for services other than the service being offered.
- Delaware Cooperative Extension and MGs do not endorse any commercial horticultural service or brand.

Conditions

- By submitting your application you agree to permit the visiting MGs to photograph your property for use in educational and promotional materials. No photographs will be taken of any people or pets except by separate written consent.
- A MG volunteer will contact you as soon as possible to discuss your application and to schedule a mutually acceptable time for the home visit. The ability to provide a visiting team is subject to the availability of volunteers for your preferred date(s) and time(s).
- Each visiting team will have a minimum of two MG volunteers.
- The visiting team will spend up to two hours at your property to view your property and make recommendations based on your priorities.
