GROW YOUR OWN BEETS

General Information

- Beta vulgaris, Beets
- Amaranthaceae family
- Sunlight: full sun.
- Soil conditions: fertile, evenly moist soil, free of rocks.
- Beets need cool temperatures to germinate and grow.

Successful Cultivars

- Zeppo (50 days) Smooth skin, round shape. (pictured here)
- Bulls Blood (35 days baby leaf) (58 days roots) Deep burgundy leaves. Attractive deep red roots with striped zoning when sliced.
- Touhtone Gold (55 days) Striking gold color, retains color when cooked.

Common Pests & Diseases

- Leaf miners (pictured here)
- Flea beetles
- Leafhoppers
- Scab
- Leaf Spot
