

GROW YOUR OWN BRUSSELS SPROUTS

General Information

- *Brassica oleracea* var. *gemmifera*, Brussels Sprouts
- Brassicaceae family
- Sunlight: full sun.
- Soil Conditions: consistently moist, fertile soil.
- Can be harvested as stalks or as sprouts.



Successful Cultivars

- Gladius (98 days) Early, firm, holds well.
- Dagan (100 days) Attractive, smooth, holds well.
- Green Gems (85-90 days) Green exterior with golden interior. Cold hardy 1 ½" sprouts.



Common Pests & Diseases

- Cabbage worm
- Flea beetle (pictured here)
- Root maggots
- Clubroot
