General Information

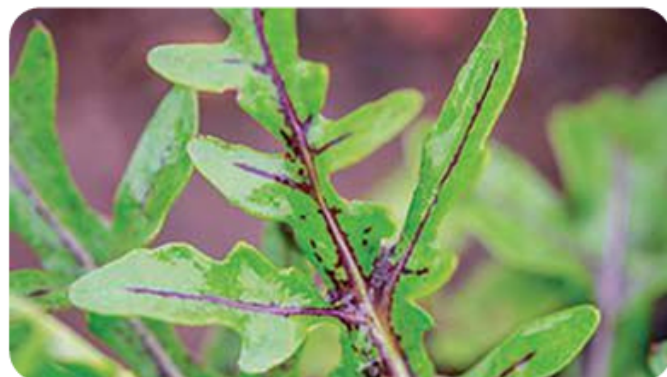
- *Eruca sativa*, Arugula
- Brassicaceae family (mustards)
- Sunlight: full sun. Light shade may help slow bolting.
- Soil conditions: rich, well-drained soil.

Successful Cultivators

- Rocket (35 days) Tender, smooth leaves, robust peppery flavor.
- Red Dragon (45-50 days) Oak-shaped leaves with striking maroon veins.



Pests and Diseases

- Flea beetle
- Downy mildew
- Root rot
- Aphids
- Bacterial leaf spot
