## **General Information**

- Pisum sativum (Peas) Fabaceae Family (Legume)
- Sunlight: full sun.
- Soil conditions: fertile, well drained soil.
- Can tolerate light frost. Bush and vining varieties.

## Successful Cultivars

- Maxigolt (65 days) Shelling type. Broad pods contain large, sweet, dark green peas.
- Sugar Snap (58 days) Snap type. Flavorful, sweet, crisp pods.
- Avalanche (60 days) Snow type. High yielding, dark green pods.

## Common Pests & Diseases

- Pea root rot
- Powdery Mildew
- Fusarium Wilt\*
- Aphids \*Pictured here.
