General Information

- Brassica oleracea var. gongylodes (Kohlrabi)
 - Brassicaceae Family
- Sunlight: full sun. Tolerates light shade.
- Soil conditions: prefers well-drained, fertile soil high in organic matter.

Successful Cultivators

- Delicacy White (60 days) Light green skin.
- Delicacy Purple (65 days) Vibrant purple skin, white flesh.
- Quickstar (37 days) Green skin, exceptional earliness, good flavor.

Common Pests and Diseases

- Cutworm
- Cabbage looper Cabbageworm (pictured here)
- Flea beetle
- Cabbage root maggots Black rot
- Cabbage yellows
