

Vegetable Farm Internship

Fresh to You, the University of Delaware's organic farm, is looking for interns who are interested in learning about vegetable production. Summer interns will participate in all aspects of the farm including propagation, crop maintenance, harvesting, farm stand sales, and more. Starting in the fall, the farm will start its community supported agriculture (CSA) program for university employees to help increase access to fresh and local produce throughout the year. Fall interns will also get a chance to participate in this exciting new program and will help to prepare CSA boxes that will be picked up weekly at the farm.



The purpose of the Center for Food Systems and Sustainability Undergraduate Internship Program is to provide opportunities for current undergraduate students or recent graduates to engage in research projects or extension efforts that align with CENFOODS goals to coordinate, integrate, and enhance UD's research, teaching and outreach efforts on the sustainability of food production and surrounding ecosystems.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be current undergraduate students at the University of Delaware (with a GPA of 2.5 or above)
- Please remember, we will be working outside most of the time (in all types of weather). Applicants should be able to lift at least 35lbs and be comfortable on their feet for extended periods of time

Funding Rates and Duration

- Internships will be for a total of 12 weeks
 - Summer interns: June to August, 20 hours per week
 - Fall interns: August to November, 12 hours per week
 - Pay: \$12 per hour
