



Academic Enrichment Award • 2021-2022

Academic Enrichment Awards were created by the UD Alumni Association (UDAA) in 2001 to provide, through financial assistance, an opportunity for students to enrich their education at the University of Delaware. **In 2011, the criterion for funding was updated and only legacy students are eligible to receive funding. Legacy is defined as a student whose parent or step-parent who is a UD graduate.** Preference is given to first-time applicants, undergraduates and students who have found other funding sources. Up to \$2,000 per student may be awarded to allow a student to take part in an opportunity in which he/she may not otherwise be able to participate. These opportunities to enrich the UD experience may include, but are not limited to, academic competitions, symposia, conferences, leadership programs or other academic endeavors. *If opportunities to travel during the 2021-2022 school year are unavailable, online conferences or webinars are still eligible for consideration for the UDAA Academic Enrichment Award.*

Examples of recent programs receiving individual awards include:

- Performing at the Chamber Music Festival in Bastad, Sweden.
- Presentation of research at the International Conference of the Book in Madrid.
- Receiving an award at Music Teacher's National Association Conference.

Students with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or above are eligible to apply. Receipts must be submitted for all money received. No portion of the award may be used for alcohol. Study abroad programs without additional discovery, research or service learning opportunities are not eligible. **Please refer to the AEA website for a full description of funding criteria and guidelines.**

Applications will be considered two times during the 2021-2022 year, according to the following schedule:

Funds are limited so applicants are encouraged to apply at the earliest possible deadline.

To apply for the Academic Enrichment Award, complete the attached application and submit it along with:

- An essay, not to exceed two pages, explaining why you are a good candidate for this award, detailing your legacy connection and what your UD legacy connection means to you.
- Include, in essay or otherwise, a detailed description of the program, conference, competition, etc. for which you wish funding and indicate the dollar amount you would like to receive (\$2,000 maximum per student per year).
- Include detailed documentation that verifies the cost of the program (i.e. website printouts, travel agent quotes, mileage estimates for gas costs from website, etc). The committee needs to see how your costs are calculated and where the estimates came from. An expense form is included in the application to help you calculate the amount of your request.
- One letter of reference from your faculty advisor or a member of the UD community who endorses your proposal and how you would use the award. Reference letters from outside UD may be submitted as additional support.
- An unofficial or official copy of your transcript.

The UDAA carefully reviews every application for an Academic Enrichment Award in accordance with the above criteria. As funding is limited, all eligible individuals may not receive an award. The decision of the AEA Committee as to whether to grant an award is final. The UDAA reserves the right to determine the criteria for awarding AEA funding.
