- Running 10-12 meetings per semester;
- Ensuring that children are dismissed safely at the end of the club/enrichment meeting.
- Letting the director know ahead of time what materials you may need to run your program so that we can make sure you are well equipped to engage the youngsters.

Qualifications:

We are looking for individuals who are dedicated, enthusiastic, and committed to the educational growth of young minds. Pre-service teachers/counselors are encouraged to apply.
