The Department of Languages, Literatures and Cultures at the University of Delaware in Newark, DE, seeks a dynamic and innovative instructor to teach Korean language courses at the beginning level of the curriculum in Spring 2026. This 4-credit course will be offered online in the spring 2026 semester, but we would prefer to hire an instructor who can access the Newark campus, given that in-person courses may be offered in subsequent semesters as needed by the department.

Qualifications and Responsibilities

The successful candidate will have an MA in Korean Language, Literature, Linguistics, or Second Language Acquisition & Teaching, and should have native or near-native fluency in both Korean and English. Experience teaching college-level Korean in the US is highly desired.

The core responsibilities of this position include teaching Korean-language classes as needed by the department and contributing to the development of the Korean program. Candidates should be:

- committed to high-quality instruction in a collaborative, communicative-based learning environment;
- able to work with a wide range of students and learning styles;
- willing to collaborate with colleagues to advance student outcomes; and
- experienced with using technology to foster student learning.

The instructor is also expected to hold one hour of student office hours per course per week.
