Supplemental Faculty (Adjunct) Position for Italian

The Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures at the University of Delaware invites applications for a one-semester supplemental faculty position without review to teach one section (four credit hours) of first-year Italian Language (100-level) in the fall 2025 semester. This course may be taught online. A supplemental faculty member is equivalent to what is called an 'adjunct' role at many institutions. These are part-time, non-benefited positions. We will begin reviewing applications immediately. The position will remain open until filled.

The Italian program in DLLC teaches Italian language, literature, and culture courses to a robust community of undergraduate students. The 100-level language curriculum is coordinated by a Sequence Supervisor to ensure continuity across all sections.

Responsibilities

The successful applicant will have native or near-native proficiency in Italian. Experience teaching undergraduate Italian language and culture is preferred. The successful applicant must be able to work productively as part of a collaborative, multi-section language team.

Pay Rate Range

This is a temporary, part-time, non-benefited position. Rate of pay is based on level of education. In Spring 2025, adjunct faculty with a master's degree were paid \$1710 per credit (\$6840 for a four-credit course), and adjuncts with a doctoral degree were paid \$2066 per credit (\$8264 for a four-credit course). Supplemental pay rates are reviewed annually, and rates for the 2025-26 academic year will be posted by August.

Minimum Qualifications

The successful applicant will have at least a Master's degree or equivalent in Italian.

Preferred Qualifications

Demonstrated ability to teach Italian is preferred.
