Students who take an AP course that is also part of a **high school/college program** cannot receive credit for both the test and the Dual Enrollment transcript. In most cases, UD recognizes the college transfer work and does not award the AP credit. The Registrar's Office reviews these cases at the beginning of each major semester, determines the correct award, and will notify students if any changes are made to their academic records. Examination equivalencies below are **subject to update**, and are for **students matriculating to UD in 2026-2027**.
