Special Requirements

Anderson-Rosenfeld Diversity Scholarship – Student must be in the College of Arts & Sciences with special consideration given to students who have overcome obstacles such as social economic or educational disadvantages or disabilities, first generation in their family to attend college, are members of groups that are underrepresented at the University or are women studying in fields where they are underrepresented.

Gregory R. Baker '83 Scholarship Fund – Undergraduate students who matriculated to the University of Delaware following the successful completion of an Associates in Arts degree. Recipient must be a graduate from a Sussex County, DE public high school, must exhibit financial need and be in good academic standing.

David G Butler Residence Hall Leadership Scholarship-Undergraduate student who is entering into their sophomore, junior or senior year and resides in University housing. Candidate must describe their participation and extent of involvement in their University recognized and approved student organization(s). Candidate must identify which student organization(s) and indicate the hours per week/month that was contributed to its goals as well as any position they may have held in the organization(s). Candidate must also list accomplishments within their University activities and demonstrate how the University community benefited from their activities. *Candidate must provide contact information for each University recognized and approved student organization.*

Ricky Barbour Memorial Scholarship- Interested in pursuing a degree in law and involvement in club sports or extracurricular activities. Applicants must be 1) **rising seniors** matriculated in any of the University's undergraduate degree programs; 2) applicants should be well-rounded individuals who possess demonstrated interest in **pursuing law degrees** after completing their undergraduate studies; 3) applicants should have **demonstrated involvement in club sports or extracurricular activities**.

Louis J. Capano Sr. Scholarship – Undergraduate student who is a resident of DE, student must demonstrate affiliation with a building industry.

William & Marie Cotty Engineering Scholarship – Student must be a member or former member of the Wilmington Boys' Club or its successor organization majoring in Engineering. Next preference will be given to member or former member of the Wilmington Boys' Club or its successor organization majoring in any other discipline.

Elmer E. Deaver Foundation Scholarship – Student must be related to a former employee of the Quaker City Life Insurance Co. Proof of this relationship must be provided with application.

Evergreen Scholarship – Student must demonstrate financial need and be in good academic standing. Student must maintain some form of employment to help pay for his/her education, documentation must be provided with application, ie W-2 or most current pay stub.

The Harker Family Scholarship—awarded to an undergraduate student matriculated in either the Lerner College of Business & Economics or the College of Engineering who represent the first generation of their immediate family to attend an institution of Higher Education.

Jacobsen Scholarship-Applicants must be a rising sophomore, junior or senior who is matriculated in the College of Arts & Sciences with the intent of pursuing a law degree.

Michael Lee Scholarship- Student must have faced social, economical and cultural challenges or other life circumstances.

Schimmel Memorial Scholarship- Student must be a child of any law enforcement officer (living or deceased) employed in the State of Delaware. This includes law enforcement in any jurisdiction within the State of Delaware. *Proof must be provided with application.*

Wilmington Trust Company Scholarship- The Wilmington Trust Endowed Scholarship fund is to be used for the children of current and/or former/retired Wilmington Trust employees. Student must be pursuing an undergraduate degree and have demonstrated need by completing the FAFSA. You must provide the M&T Bank corporation Employee Name and ID number as indicated on first page of application. (If applying as a former Wilmington Trust employee, please provide your Wilmington Trust ID number.)

Richard A. Wilson Memorial Scholarship-Awarded to diverse students who show academic promise and volunteer service to the community.
