Loans and Grants

- Federal:
 - Pell Grant is based on SAI and amount is determined by filing the FAFSA
 - Loans include direct loans borrowed by the student and Parent PLUS borrowed by the parent
 - Due to new federal legislation, PLUS loans dispersed after July 1, 2026 will have a limit of \$20k per student per year with a lifetime borrowing limit of \$65k
- Private:
 - Private education loan requirements are dependent on the lender
 - Usually require a credit check
