Evacuation Meeting Locations



Do you know where to meet if there was a **fire** or **building emergency**? Take a look at the building evacuation maps located in each hallway, they will show you the exact location.

- Brown Lab meets at Hullihen Hall
- Lammot du Pont meets at Memorial Hall
- Drake Lab meets at Colburn Lab

Once you are at the meeting spot please DO NOT leave, but check-in with the person in charge. You need to be accounted for and you may have information that can aid first responders during the emergency situation.

How to Triple Rinse a container

Over the past few weeks several incorrectly "triple rinsed" containers have been placed in the blue compactor. What is the proper method?

- Triple rinse with copious amounts of water. Collect the first rinse as chemical waste. Rinse two and three can go down the sanitary sewer.
- Place a label over the original container label or deface the label and write *empty* <u>and</u> *triple rinse.*
- 3. Do not replace the cap on the container.

Place empty/triple rinsed containers in a lab trash box or directly into the blue compactor.
